


**MLA 5.0 Renewal Addendum
(New Term and Volume Discount)**

This Addendum modifies Master License Agreement, version 5.0 ("MLA"), between State of Nevada ("Prime Customer") and Novell, Inc. ("Novell"), MLA #M5Z108.

1. **Definitions.** Terms with the initial letter capitalized will have the same meaning as defined in the MLA, unless otherwise defined in this Addendum.
2. **Amendments to MLA.** The MLA is modified as follows:
 - a. **Term.** The parties agree to renew the MLA for an additional term (the "New Term"), which shall begin upon expiration of the old term and expire on 6/30/2002. Subsequently, the MLA will be automatically renewed for additional terms of two-year periods until either party gives written notice otherwise at least sixty days prior to the end of the then-current MLA term.
 - b. Section 2.36, Volume Discount, is replaced with the following:

Customer's Volume Discount for purchases of Licenses and Maintenance is 40 percent during the New Term of the MLA. For any subsequent terms, the Volume Discount shall be as described in the then-current MLA program.
 - c. Electronic Ordering. Customer agrees that an MLA order submitted using Customer's electronic password on Novell's electronic MLA ordering system shall have the same validity and effect as if Customer had submitted the order on a paper MLA Order Form signed by an authorized Customer representative.
 - d. MLA Coordinators. With this Addendum, Customer shall submit the attached Exhibit A, "MLA Coordinators," which shall contain the current information regarding the party's MLA coordinators, and replaces previous coordinator information provided under the MLA.
 - e. Commercial Public Network Service ("CPNS") Restriction. Customer may not use the Software in a CPNS in which the number of CPNS subscribers exceeds 5000, unless Customer first obtains a separate license from Novell (see <http://www.novell.com/internet>). A CPNS is a service offered to the general public or to businesses that provides Internet access, virtual private networking, remote network management, access to corporate or other networks, or access to any remote computing device, application, service or data.
3. **Customer Audit / Purchase Order.** Upon execution of this Addendum and in accordance with each Customer's MLA audit obligations, each Customer shall submit to Novell a complete and accurate written report of the total number of Nodes/copies of each Licensed Work copied or used by Customer. Customer must also submit with the audit report a completed and signed purchase order for maintenance for the upcoming Annual Period.
4. **Continuance.** Except as expressly amended by this Addendum, the MLA terms and conditions remain in effect unchanged. If and to the extent that any inconsistency may appear between the MLA and this Addendum, the Addendum provisions shall control.


